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CORAVIN™

The Coravin Wine Preservation Opener uses a medical grade needle and a proprietary capsule of Argon gas to pour a bottle of wine through the cork. The cork is never removed. This helps prevent oxidation, increasing the longevity of the wine. It accomplishes this by first inserting a hollow needle through the cork. The user then presses a trigger to pressurize the bottle with argon gas. When the user releases the trigger, the wine pours into the glass. The needle is removed from the cork, a naturally elastic and porous material, which then reseals, protecting the wine from oxidation and leaving the remaining wine unaffected

This is the flagship wine of Champagne Louis Roederer, a blend of about 65% Pinot Noir and 35% Chardonnay encompassing a number of vintages. Noted for its discreet fruit and subtle toast flavors, it doubles as a refreshing aperitif or a versatile food wine.

**BANDINI** Prosecco DOC NV Veneto Italy 13  
 This Italian Prosecco's bouquet is delicate and complex with fruity notes of peach and green apple and secondary notes of acacia and wisteria. The palate is fresh and light with good acid balance and a creamy, harmonious mouthfeel and pleasing persistence.

**Clover Hill** Tasmanian Cuvee Brut NV Tamara River TAS 15  
 Straw colour with pale gold edges and exceptionally fine bead The palate displays breadly baked apple flavours followed by some subtle toast and yeast lees characters. Clean dry finish with an almost creamy like mouthfeel. Long aftertaste of baked apple, toasty bread and yeast lees.

#### WHITE 150ML

**Alkoomi** Reisling 2017 Frankland River WA 14  
 The soft and delicate on palate with combination of lime and bath salts. It show a dry precise riesling with texture, spice and acidity that give the wine focus and fantastic length. Consistent with the now well-established Rieslings from Frankland in an exceptional wine that can be enjoyed now or cellared

**Dog point** Sauvignon Blanc 2016 Marlborough NZ 15  
 Very pale straw-yellow colour with slight green hues, lighter on the rim. The nose is very fresh with intense, penetrating aromas of gooseberries, and green stone fruits with dark herbs, unfolding white and yellow floral notes and subtle, complexing mineral elements. Dry to taste and medium-bodied, A real Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc .

**Serra Da Estrela** Albarino 2017 Rias Baixas Spain 14  
 A classic Albarino Fresh peach in a bowl describes how this nicely made Albariño smells. Its round, full-bodied palate is balanced with acidity. And its fresh peach and apricot flavors lead to a chalky and mineral finish.

**Alois Lageder** Pinot Grigio DOC 2017 Alto Adige Italy 14  
 Northern Italy Pinot Grigio has Bouquet and flavors of freshly grated citrus, apricot, dried apples, grapefruit, nectarine and almonds. It is crisp, refreshing and reveals a slight minerality on the finish Great structure and great acidity to pair with grilled seafood.

**Giant Steps** Chardonnay 2018 Yarra Valley VIC 16  
 Honey and butter mixed together for the nose, Medium length. Golden with greenish tinge, delicate nose of citrus, white fruits. Medium bodied, deliciously elegant, touch of vanilla, opens up in the glass and increases enjoyment. A great value Burgundie once in mouth it is very light, smooth and gentle. Just like a perfect partner for a white and slowly cooked fish pairing.

**E. Guigal** Blanc 2015 Cotes du Rhone France 15  
 65% Viognier .15% Roussanne, 8% Marsanne, 8% clairette, 2% Bourboulenc, 2% White Grenache This wine is both fresh and rich, with complex aromas and flavors of honeysuckle, pear, and kiwi, and a deep mineral streak. It is a beautiful, seamless wine that represents unbelievable value. Perfume and violet aromas, intense bright raspberry and cherry fruits long finish

**Rockford** White Frontignac 2018 Barossa Valley SA 13  
 A beautifully floral on the nose. It shows white flowers, fresh rose petals, lemons and stone fruits. This i a lively exotic fruitiness that races through the whole palate. A touch sweet but it's intrinsic acid backbone balances it perfectly.

**Nanny Goat** Pinot Noir 2017 Central Otago NZ 14  
 Greeted on the nose with notes of bramble and spice, quickly opening up to reveal dark berry fruits, The entry to the palate is rich, with sweet berry fruits nicely balanced by mouth-watering juicy acidity. Firm but fine tannins frame the mid palate

**Pira** Dolcetto D'Alba DOC 2016 Piedmont Italy 14  
 From the land of Dolecetto its a complex wine with fruity and spicy notes .The taste is young, round mouth filling , with sweet, gentle and persistent tannins. A balanced Wine.

**Crittenden Estate** Pinocchio Sangiovese 2017 Mornington Peninsula VIC 13

This Pinocchio Sangiovese is bright ruby in color. A perfumed bouquet and a luscious palate full of bitter Morello cherries and light savoury characters. A firm layer of fine acidity and dry tannins integrate with the enticing palate, to offer a long and refreshing finish.

**\*Tatiara** Caravan Of Dreams Shiraz 2015 Heathcote VIC 21  
 For lovers of the Shiraz,with Incredible length. Incredible depth of flavour.. Expressive liquorice and blackberry scents leap out of the glass with distinctive overtones of dark plum and dark chocolate followed by some vanilla oak and light spice.. Exceptional power with remarkably velvet tannins. Rich and a muscular wine

**Terramore** Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 Coonawarra SA 14  
 A well balanced, medium-bodied cabernet showing Coonawarra at its best with little age. On palate Hint of spice, coffee and a touch of mulberry all come together well, dark fruits dark chocolate little oak with Soft tannins.

**Sc Pannell** Dead End Tempranillo 2016 McLaren Vale SA 17  
 A Highly perfumed, vibrant and complex with sweet black cherries, sarsaparilla, coffee beans and good hints of roasted exotic spice. Structure & Texture is Juicy, full and supple, but tannic right on the finish. The persistence of the tannins is the signature.

**Craggy Range** Gimblett Gravels Vineyard Merlot 2010 Hawke's Bay NZ 16  
 Dark garnet with vibrant purple hues. aromas of ripe plum, cassis, nutmeg, tobacco and sandalwood reflects beautifully ripe Merlot. The palate is at first rich and full bodied and then finishes with wonderful graphite-like tannins, fine acidity and a long tapering dry finish.

**Robert Chevillon** 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Les Perrieres 2002 Nuits Saint Georges 49  
 2002 Perrieres when this great base of soil is coupled with vividly beautiful, sappy fruit tones. This is exactly what this superb wine offers in spades, as it soars from the glass in a sappy mélange of red and black cherries, cocoa, stony minerality, nutskin, woodsmoke, a nice touch of fresh herbs and a judicious framing of vanillin oak.. it's a real "head-turner" when it reaches maturity.

**Penfold's** Grange Bin 95 Shiraz 1993 Barossa Valley SA 249  
 86% Shiraz 14% Cabernet Sauvignon.  
 Kalimna Vineyard (Barossa Valley), Barossa Valley, Coonawarra Blend. A very wet growing season was followed by warm drier conditions resulting in a very late but sound quality vintage fruit. An Indian Summer in Coonawarra delivered fully ripened fruit.

**Mount Mary** Quintet 2005 Yarra Valley VIC 59  
 (48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Cabernet Franc, 26% Merlot, 5% Malbec, 3% Petit Verdot)  
 A tressure of Yarra Valley , Really inky and pure, huge intensity. One of the best wines of the bracket. Opulent and complex. Classic Quintet!

**Pizzini** 'Coronamento' Reserve Nebbiolo 2002 King Valley VIC 49  
 Coronamento is an Italian word that translates to crowning of one's achievements it has always been a dream to produce a reserve style Nebbiolo. Red liquorice, red plums, exotic spice, saffron and hints of leather, earth and toasted hazelnuts are all here. The palate has impressive Power and grace, it is really deep and even-handed with a wealth of ripe red cherry fruit flavours, and supple, yet commanding tannins which are long lasting, even and juicy.

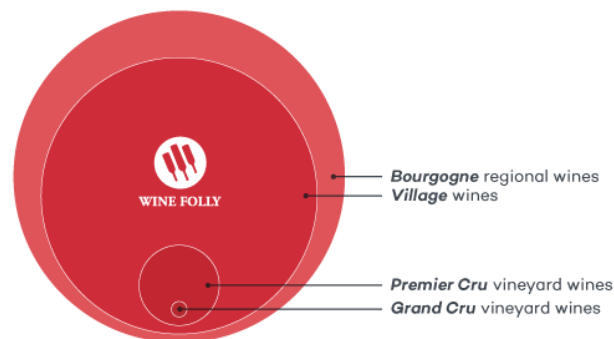

## THE STORY OF GRANGE

In 1957, Max Schubert was asked to show his efforts in Sydney to top management, invited wine identities and personal friends of the board. To his horror and humiliation the Grange experiment was universally disliked. Even further tastings in Adelaide resulted in negative opinion. One critic observed, 'Schubert, I congratulate you. A very good, dry port, which no one in their right mind will buy - let alone drink.' Embarrassed, angry and dejected, Max Schubert's ambitions to make 'a great wine that Australians would be proud of' were completely destroyed. Grange was dead.

It was the happenstance of distance between senior management in Sydney and winemakers in Adelaide, 1,400 kilometres apart, which saved Grange. With the help of Magill's assistant general manager Jeffrey Penfold Hyland and Schubert's team of winemakers, all the experimental Grange was hidden in the underground cellars of Magill and from 1957 to 1959, the 'hidden Granges' were made without the knowledge of the Penfolds board. Max Schubert continued to source fruit and make his experiments in secret.

Although management was kept away, friends and associates were occasionally brought in to taste the wines. Some bottles were even given away. Although considered uncommercial in 1957, news was filtering out about Schubert's unique Grange Hermitage. A second tasting with the same board members was organised of the 1951 and 1955 vintages, both with bottle age development, were greeted with enthusiasm (the 1955 went on to have a very successful wine show career). The Penfolds board ordered production of Grange to restart, just in time for the 1960 vintage. During the 1960s Grange firmed its position as Australia's most distinguished wine. The rest is history. It marked the beginning of a 'dynasty of wines' that would capture the imagination of the Australian wine consumer.

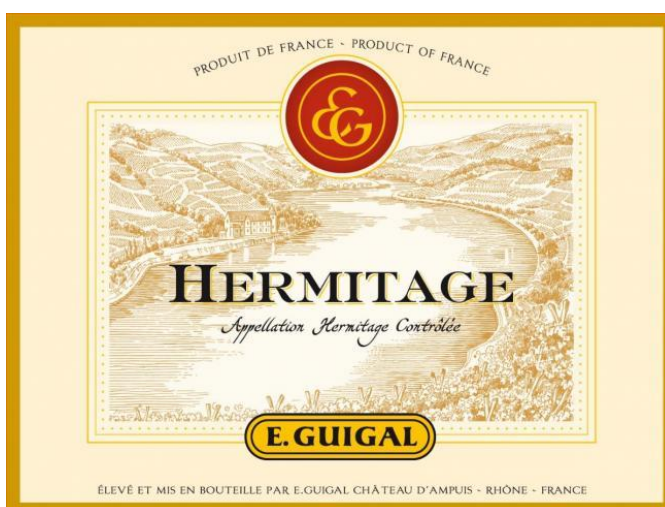

Argentina is the 5<sup>th</sup> biggest producer of wine in the world and has a very long winemaking heritage dating back to the 1600's, not that the wine made then was anything like what is drunk today! Between 1885 and 1920 Malbec quickly spread to other wine regions such as Patagonia and Salta Although in the 1970's some people quietly started making 100% Malbec. In 1966 there were 57,000 acres of the grape. This rapid change in Argentina drinking culture forced wineries to change their game and export their wines in order to keep the industry going. Argentina would have to adapt in order to sell it abroad – the wine Argentines drank was very different to the wine most international consumers bought from the US and Australia in the late 80's, for example. An influx of wine consultants and interest at home in the 90's slowly brought Argentina up to date. Malbec now is the most widely planted grape in Argentina and exports have grown dramatically as people around the world enjoy the easy drinking red varietal!

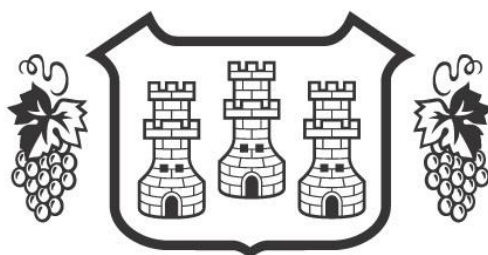
